<u>Curriculum Sharing Option:</u> Module books may be shared with an additional registrant at your credit union. One set of tests is free with each set of modules ordered. If sharing modules, CUNA charges an additional test fee of \$30 per module for additional participants which will total \$240 for all eight tests/modules.

<u>REAL Solutions Training Sessions:</u> The REAL Solutions fee of \$357 per participant is funded by the Michigan Credit Union Foundation. Therefore, there will be no additional participation fee to credit unions for the group sessions or webinars. Bi-weekly webinars and live group training sessions will be conducted by REAL Solutions, the signature program of the National Credit Union Foundation. Approximate schedule:

- Bi-Weekly webinars will be held from May to October: One orientation webinar and eight bi-weekly webinars; one for each module webinars will be recorded.
- Two live group sessions will be held for training and testing. These will be one day sessions scheduled in July or August for part one and in October for part two with exact dates and locations to be announced.
