



2011 CUNA MANAGEMENT SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Michigan Credit Union Foundation is now accepting applications for scholarships for 2011 CUNA Management School in Madison, Wisconsin from July 11-22, 2011. These scholarships are awarded annually to encourage the development of professionals committed to serving in the credit union system.

Attendance at CUNA Management School benefits both new and experienced managers who are committed to improving and enhancing their existing supervisory and management skills, supervisors with little or no formal training, staff who have been identified for future advancement, and those who aspire to achieve a supervisory and management position within their credit unions.

The MCUF offers CUNA Management School Scholarships through the below funds:

- **EBAUGH-LESNIESKI MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP** covers the comprehensive* fee to first, second or third-year CUNA Management School attendees. There are no credit union asset restrictions. One scholarship will be awarded.
- **VANDERVEEN MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP** covers the comprehensive* fee to first-year CUNA Management School attendees. Applicants must have completed at least two years of credit union service. There are no credit union asset restrictions. One scholarship will be awarded.
- **GENERAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP** covers the comprehensive* fee to first, second or third-year CUNA Management School attendees. Applicants must have completed at least two years of credit union service. There are no credit union asset restrictions. One scholarship will be awarded.

*Each MCUF scholarship covers the CUNA Management School comprehensive fee of \$2,299 (\$2,399 after May 29, 2011). The fee includes tuition, materials, hotel (double occupancy) and most meals. Travel and spouse expenses are not included in the award.

Individuals applying for a CUNA Management School scholarship from MCUF are encouraged to apply for scholarships from other sources as well. CUNA offers scholarships to CUNA Management School.
