# **Student Experience:**

- Choose a career, receive a starting salary with deductions
- Are assigned a credit score
- Actively making spending decisions at lifestyle stations led by credit union and community volunteers
- Borrow and save at the credit union
- Balance their budget in order to live within their means
- Visit a financial counselor to explore ways to improve their financial future
- Option to use event app or paper workbooks

# **Requirements:**

- Host credit union(s) and 1-2 lead coordinators
- 30-300 high school students
- Large room for Lifestyle Stations
- 11/2 21/2 hours total time per group of 100 students

### **Credit Unions Role:**

- Host credit unions(s) provide lead coordinator(s) and most station volunteers
- Print/prepare station materials and student workbooks (if using)
- Create branded signage or borrow Financial Reality Fair kit from MCUF

\*MCUF grant funding available for CUs interested in creating their own branded event signage.


