

Virtual Tabletop Exercise Cyber Incident Response

WHAT: The Mid-Michigan Chapter, in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the National Credit Union Information Sharing & Analysis Organization (NCU-ISAO), will host a Cyber Incident Virtual Tabletop Exercise (VTTX.)



The exercise seeks to create an opportunity to:

- Enhance the cyber incident preparedness of the chapter's credit unions.
- Examine cybersecurity information sharing processes during both steady-state and incident response.
- Discuss plans, policies, and procedures that guide cyber incident response actions.
- Discuss the resources and capabilities required to respond to a cyber incident.

The following topics will be highlighted during the exercise: Phishing, Malware, Website Defacement and Ransomware.

WHY: Mature your credit union's incident response program to expedite and enhance your response following a cyber-attack.

WHO*: Executives, members of your incident response team or those who want exposure to cyber security model testing

* The VTTX is designed for all levels of understanding of cyber security, though it may be best suited for those in your organization with cyber and related incident response knowledge & responsibilities.

HOW: The VTTX will be hosted via live audio/web conferencing. The format allows credit unions to consider aspects of cyber preparedness within their own institutions, participate in break-out sessions with other credit unions, and to share best practices.
