Rising cellist Cameron Renshaw is gaining recognition for expressive performances that are beyond his years. Most recently, he received the "First Great Award" at the 6th Manhattan International Music Competition and performed at the Gala Concert in Carnegie Hall in July 2022.

In 2019, he made his orchestral solo debut with the Moscow Symphony Orchestra, after just two years of playing the cello. As a first place or grand prize winner of dozens of international competitions, he has had the honor of performing in some of the world's greatest concert halls, such as Carnegie Hall and the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam.

He has been featured on local and national media and in a performance on "The Ellen Degeneres Show" in 2020.
