- Borrow and save at the credit union
- Balance their budget in order to live within their means
- Visit a financial counselor to explore ways to improve their financial future
- Option to use budget app or paper budget worksheet

Requirements:

- Host credit union(s) and 1-2 lead coordinators
- 50-300 high school students
- Large room for Lifestyle Stations
- 2 2 ½ hours total time per group of 100 students

- Budget app or customized budget worksheets
- Signage and station materials
